ENC 1101: English Composition One (face to face; mixed mode; web). This first-year writing course develops students' knowledge of what writing is and how it functions in the world, with a focus on understanding writing as situated within academic, professional, civic, and personal contexts.

ENC 1102: English Composition Two (face to face; mixed mode; web). This first-year writing course introduces students to inquiry-based academic research processes, library research, and argumentation in scholarly contexts.

ENC 1101: English Composition One (mixed mode). This first-year writing course focuses on clarity of central and supporting ideas, adequate development, logical organization, coherence, appropriate citing of primary and/or secondary sources, and grammatical and mechanical accuracy.

ENC 1102: English Composition Two (face to face). This first-year writing course focuses on style; use of library resources; reading and evaluating available sources; and planning, writing, and documenting a short research paper.
